Time Warner Cable News / Siena College 52nd State Senate District Poll:

Akshar Lead Over Fiala Balloons to 72 to 20%

Favorability Ratings Moving in Opposite Directions; Akshar Hugely Positive, Fiala Overwhelmingly Negative

68% of Akshar Voters say 'no chance will change their mind'; Only 55% of Fiala's Supporters Absolutely Certain

By 56 to 18% Fiala seen as Waging More Negative Race

This Time Warner Cable News/Siena College 52nd S.D. survey was conducted October 22-25, 2015 by telephone calls to 643 likely voters. The results have a margin of error of ± 4.4 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting. Sampling was conducted via a stratified dual frame sample of historically active registered voters reached via landline telephone numbers provided by Prime New York and cell phone telephone numbers provided by Survey Sampling International. A likely voter screen was applied to initial respondents from this dual frame sample that was statistically adjusted to reflect party registration, gender and age.
