This Newsday/News 12/ Siena College Nassau County District Attorney survey was conducted October 23-28, 2015 by telephone calls in English to 596 registered and likely voters. The results have a margin of error of ± 4.1 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting. Sampling was conducted via a stratified dual frame (land and cell) probability sample provided by Survey Sampling International. A likely voter screen was applied to initial respondents from this dual frame sample that was statistically adjusted to reflect historic voter turnout by party, gender and age.
