This Newsday/News 12/ Siena College Suffolk County Executive survey was conducted September 24-30, 2015 by telephone calls in English to 400 registered and likely voters. The results have a margin of error of ± 5.0 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting. Sampling was conducted via a stratified dual frame (land and cell) probability sample provided by Survey Sampling International. A likely voter screen was applied to initial respondents from this dual frame sample that was statistically adjusted to reflect party registration, gender and age.
