Telephone sampling was conducted via a stratified dual frame probability sample of landline (ASDE) and cell phone (Dynata) telephone numbers within Long Island weighted to reflect known population patterns. Data was statistically adjusted by age, race/ethnicity, political party, regional vote pattern in the 2020 election, and gender to ensure representativeness. It has an overall margin of error of + 3.8 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting.
