This Siena College Poll was conducted December 4-December 7, 2022 among 816 New York State registered voters with 503 voters contacted through a dual frame (landline and cell phone) mode and 313 responses drawn from a proprietary online panel (Lucid) of New Yorkers. Telephone calls were conducted in English and respondent sampling was initiated by asking for the youngest person in the household. Telephone sampling was conducted via a stratified dual frame probability sample of landline (ASDE) and cell phone (Dynata) telephone numbers within New York State weighted to reflect known population patterns. Data from both collection modes (phone and web) was merged and statistically adjusted by age, party, race/ethnicity, education, 2020 vote by region, and 2022 vote by region, and gender to ensure representativeness. It has an overall margin of error of + 4.1 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting.
