This Newsday/Siena College Poll was conducted February 3 - 6, 2024, among 694 NY 3rd Congressional District Likely Voters. Telephone calls were conducted in English and respondents were asked for by name. Telephone sampling was conducted via a weighted stratified dual frame sample of landline and cell phone drawn from the L-2 database of registered voters. Data was statistically adjusted by age, political party, regional vote pattern in recent elections, a combined measure of stated and derived vote likelihood, and gender to ensure representativeness. It has an overall margin of error of +/- 4.2 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting.
