Of the 854 respondents, 854 respondents were drawn from a proprietary online panel (Lucid). Data from collection modes was statistically adjusted by age, party by region, race/ethnicity, region, and gender to ensure representativeness. It has an overall margin of error of $+/-3.8$ percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting.
